Albert Edgar NUNN (1862 – 1910)

Represented the Kent County Association on the Central Council from 1891 – 1893
and attended 1 meeting

Albert Edgar Nunn was born in Staplehurst, Kent in 1862.

He lived and rang at Tenterden.

He was Honorary Secretary of the Ashford District of the Kent County Association.

He was a founder member of the Central Committee formed on December 16th 1889.

He took part in many peals and could conduct Grandsire and Stedman Triples.

By profession he was a building contractor. He built Cranbrook Waterworks and did construction and repair work on the sea wall at Dymchurch.

He was a member of Tenterden Borough Council November 1892-1907 and was Mayor 1903-1904 and an alderman 1905-1907.

Circa 1900 he was Chief of Tenterden Fire Brigade.

It appears that he moved from Tenterden to London some time after 1907.

He died in 1910, being shot by his wife who shot herself afterwards.
