Representative of the Guild of Devonshire Ringers 1969 - 1974

Attended 4 meetings

Dom Paulinus Angold was born Dunstan Angold in Kingston upon Hull on December 22nd 1913.

He entered Buckfast Abbey in 1931 and was ordained in 1937, taking the monastic name of Paulinus.

During the Second World War, he spent two and a half years in Egypt, in the desert, as an army chaplain. He also served as an army chaplain in Italy. After the war, he returned to Buckfast and served as a parish priest in Ashburton and Buckfastleigh.

He worked in the stained glass workshops at the Abbey.

He enjoyed ringing bells and visited many Devon churches.

He died on 18th December 2009 and at the time of his death was the oldest monk in the English Benedictine Order.
