HENRY WILLIAM JOHN BARRETT

Representative of the Norwich Diocesan Association 1954 - 1977

Attended 21 meetings

Born at Loddon, Norfolk on 26th November 1905.

Began ringing at Loddon, Norfolk in 1920s.

Subsequently attached to Kingston on Thames in the 1930s and 1940s and returned to Loddon in 1950.

Rang his first peal on 2nd October 1923: four Minor methods at Loddon.

Rang a total of 1197 peals.

His notable achievements include: 90 peals at St Peter, Mancroft, Norwich; handbell ringing both method and tune; coordinating the centenary celebrations for the Norwich Diocesan Association; ringing at the opening of Washington Cathedral bells.

Occupation: Civil Servant.

Died on 24th June 1995.
