HAROLD GEORGE CASHMORE

Representative of the Hertford County Association in 1939 and 1945 - 1953

Attended 5 meetings

Born at Apsley End, Hertfordshire on 23rd March 1903.

Began ringing at Oxhey in 1919.

Rang his first peal on 26th November 1921: Superlative Surprise Major at Bushey Heath.

Rang a total of about 500 peals.

His notable achievements include: first peal of 4-spliced all-the-work with tenors together (Lambeth St Mary, 19.4.1947); lead the Bushey handbell band developing Surprise Major ringing on handbells from 1933 to 1953 including first peals of spliced in up to 8 methods.

Featured in the Ringing World articles 'Leading Conductors' No 28 (RW 22.7.1938) and 'Giants of the Exercise II'.

Occupation: Fitter and Turner.

Died on 29th December 1997.
