WILLIAM CATHRALL

Representative of the North Wales Association 1953 - 1956

Attended 1 meeting

William Cathrall was born in the Wrexham area on 8th July 1903.

He learned to ring at St. Giles, Wrexham at the age of 16 in 1919.

He rang a peal of Stedman Caters at Wrexham in 1969 to celebrate the Investiture of the Prince of Wales and also to commemorate 50 years of service to the Church as ringers by himself and two other ringers.

He was Tower Captain at Wrexham from 1973 until about 1986.

He was Secretary of the North Wales Association for over 50 years, having been asked to take over temporarily until a permanent secretary could be found!

He rang 29 peals for the North Wales Association.

He was a Civil Engineer by profession and retired in 1968.

He died on 1st January 1997 and his funeral was held at Wrexham on January 9th.
