

# Biographical Record

**Hubert Joseph DAY (1889 - 1952)**

**Represented the Suffolk Guild on the Central Council from 1924 - 1926.**

**Attended 0 meetings**

Hubert Joseph Day was born at Eye in Suffolk on March 27<sup>th</sup> 1889.

He learned to ring at Eye in 1902 and rang his first peal there.

He rang at least 32 peals.

He was the Secretary of the Eye District of the Suffolk Guild from 1924-1928.

He rang at St. Peter Mancroft, Norwich, on the day that peace was proclaimed after the Boer War.

He served in the 5<sup>th</sup> Suffolk Regiment of the Royal Flying Corps and Royal Air Force as a Sergeant Fitter 1915-1919.

He was a member of the Norfolk and Norwich Association until the formation of the Suffolk Guild.

He worked as a church bell hanger for George Day & Son (established 1802), church bell hangers.

He died on 8<sup>th</sup> August 1952.
