Edward West ELWELL (b. 1903)

**Represented the Chester Diocesan Guild on the Central Council
from 1924 - 1932 and attended 8 meetings**

Edward West Elwell was born on 16th February 1903 at Wednesbury in Staffordshire.

He rang at Capenhurst.

His first peal was at Eastham on October 28th 1922, when he rang the 4th to Oxford TB, Kent TB and Plain Bob Minor.

He became a member of the Chester Diocesan Guild in 1922 and was Secretary of the Guild 1923-1929.

He rang 6 peals, of which he conducted one, for the Chester Diocesan Guild.

In 'The Ringing World' of 28th August 1936, there was an account of his marriage in New York. He was resident in the USA at that time.

It is not known when he died, but it is assumed that he remained in the United States and as he married in New York and there were no bells there at that time, that he did not ring in his later life.
