Graham McKAY (1935 – 2001)

Represented the Cumberland and North Westmorland Association on the Central Council from 1959 to 1965 and attended 5 Council meetings.

Graham McKay was born on 11th July 1935 at St. Bees in Cumbria.

He learned to ring at St. Bees in 1946.

He rang his first peal at St. Bees on 2nd January 1950.

Between 1953 and 1955 he rang at St. Olave's Hart Street in London.

He was Secretary of the University of London Society from 1953-1955.

He was Secretary of the Western Branch of the Cumberland and North Westmorland Association from 1955-1958.

He rang at least 32 peals.

He worked in private practice as a solicitor in Whitehaven.

He died in January 2001 and is buried in the churchyard at St. Bees.
