ERIC NIXON (1929 – 2002)

Represented the North Staffordshire Association on the Central Council
from 1975 - 1982 and attended 5 meetings

Born at Silverdale, Staffordshire in 1929.

Learnt to ring at Silverdale whilst still at school.

Subsequently attached to Stoke on Trent and Newcastle under Lyme (where he was
ringing master in the 1980s and 1990s).

Rang his first peal in September 1949.

Rang his last peal in August 1999.

Rang 117 peals for the North Staffs Association.

Was a very talented handbell ringer having rung in a record-breaking handbell peal with
the most methods on 10 bells in the 1950s. He also devised a number of methods which
were rung to peals.

Founder member and keen supporter of the Manchester University Guild.

Died on 12th July 2002.
