PHILIP HERBERT REYNOLDS (1929 – 2005)

Represented the Lincoln Diocesan Guild on the Central Council
from 1970 - 1978 and attended 8 meetings

Philip Herbert Reynolds was born at Swineshead, Lincolnshire on 22 June 1929 and learned to ring at Swineshead in October 1949.

He rang his first peal, in three Minor methods, at Quadring in Lincolnshire on 6 December 1951.

He rang over 300 peals, his 300th being at Navenby, Lincolnshire, in seven Surprise Minor methods on June 30 1999.

He rang a peal of 38 Surprise Minor at Frampton on March 5 1955.

He was Ringing Master of the Eastern Branch of the Lincoln Diocesan Guild 1964-1967 and 1969-1970.

He was a Guild Committee representative from 1967.

He died on 11 September 2005.
